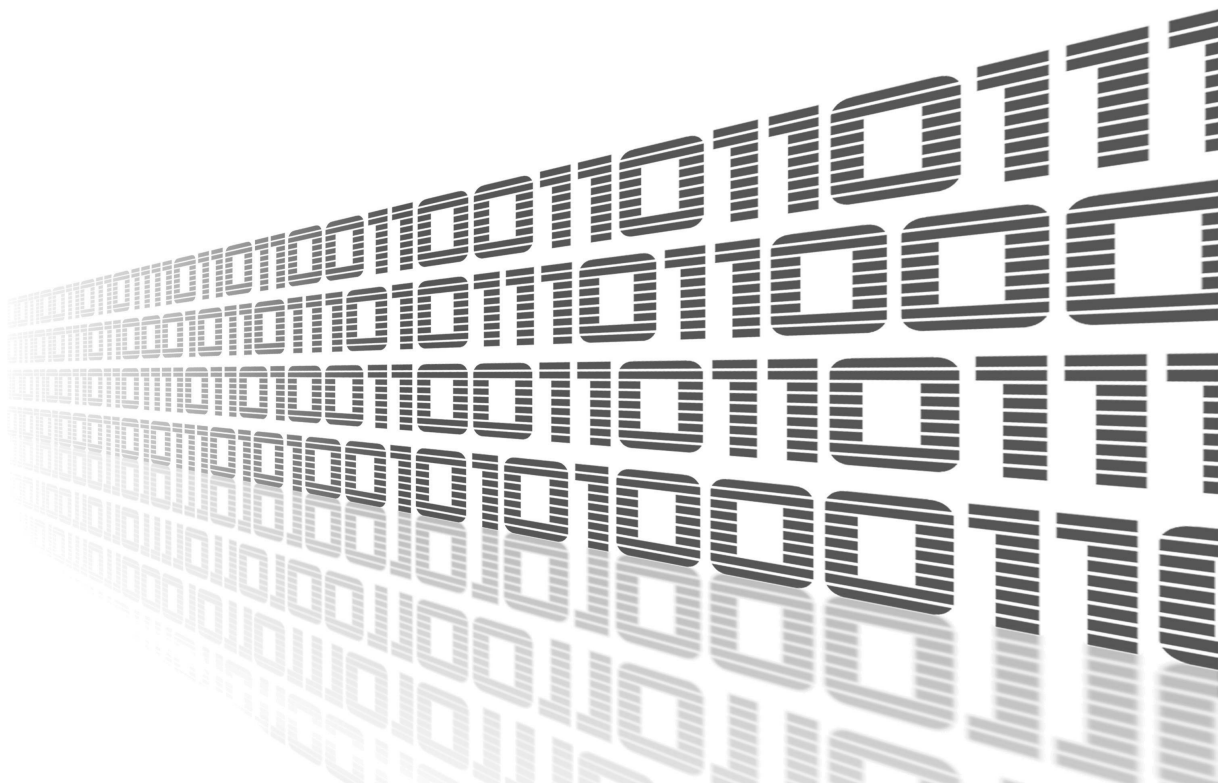

1. Description of router app



Router app *pduSMS* is not contained in the standard router firmware. Uploading of this router app is described in the Configuration manual (see Chapter [Related Documents](#)).

This router app allows the router and its users to send short text messages (SMS) to the selected number. Unlike the router's standard *Send SMS* function (in the *Administration* section of the web configuration), this module can send long SMS – messages longer than standard of 160 characters.

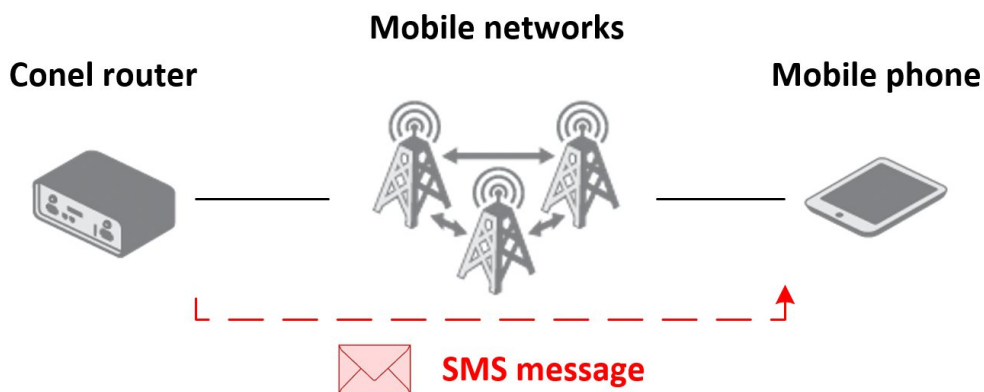


Figure 1: Example diagram

PduSMS module has a web interface which can be invoked by pressing the module name on the *Router apps* page of the router web interface. The left part of the web interface (ie. menu) contains only the *Return* item, which switches this web interface to the interface of the router. In the right part is a form for sending SMS messages. It is necessary to enter a phone number to the *Phone Number* box and text of your message to the *Message* box.

Messages can be sent not only via mentioned graphical user interface, but also in text mode. To command line enter `/opt/pduSMS/bin/pduSMS` followed by up to 20 telephone numbers separated by a space. Finally enter the desired text in english quotation marks.

Example: `/opt/pduSMS/bin/pduSMS 737123456 604789000 "Message text"`
